Our Annual Meeting is May 9, 2023 at 7 pm. We invite all members to attend. Councillor Jennifer Rice and the Honourable Richard Feehan, MLA will attend and share insights relating to our community. Come and thank Hon. Feehan for his service to our community and to the Province of Alberta as he retires and heads to Vancouver Island.

We invite you to come at 6 pm for pizza and network with your neighbours. If you are looking for opportunities to help build the community that you live in, we have opportunities for involvements on some of our committees and on the Board. We are looking for volunteers to help with programming. We need a Craft Fair director, someone to plan the kids' Halloween Party, newsletter distributor and carriers, or a volunteer to support Friday Night Fire Pits.

Duggan Tunnel Replacement

EPCOR has been a great partner with our League for the past five years as we worked together on the two drainage ponds at Ermineskin Park and Steinhauer School. It is great to see new sledding spaces being created and it will be great to see soccer and baseball once again played in both parks.

We are working with a great new EPCOR engagement team on the Duggan Tunnel Replacement project. Work began on March 7 and if everything goes smoothly will wind down in the Summer of 2024. This is an important infrastructure project that is important to the City of Edmonton and a priority issue for the League. The goal for this project is to replace the sewer lines to move effluents more efficiently with an added bonus of the elimination of sewer gas odours seeping into homes, backyards and the Community League building.

The new sewer tunnel will run from 29A Ave and 111th Street north on 111th to 34th Ave, east on 34th Ave and then north on 106 St all the way to LY Cairns school. The first of twelve, 11 storey deep, shafts will be created on 34th Ave, half way between 106th and 111th Street. This work began on March 7. In April, EPCOR will start on a shaft on the north-east corner of 34th Ave and 106 St.

This project will create traffic new congestion patterns on already busy streets:


- · 23rd Ave from QEII to Terwillegar
- from QEII along 34th to 119th Street
- · south on 111th to Twin Brooks
- of course on 106th Street right through the middle of Duggan and Rideau Park

We ask for your patience and understanding as EPCOR takes on this important piece of infrastructure. EPCOR will work with the City of Edmonton to address traffic concerns (speed, shortcutting through residential areas etc.) as they arise.

Please contact the League with any concerns and we will forward those to EPCOR.

Please come out on May 9 and get to know your neighbours.


