Construction Notice - Capital Line South LRT

24/7 excavation work at 23 Ave and 111 Street

Beginning on/around August 7, 2023, EllisDon, the City's construction manager for early works for the Capital Line South project, will begin 24/7 excavation work at the 23 Avenue and 111 Street intersection. EllisDon has obtained an extension to their overnight noise permit (BYLAW NO. 14600) that allows crews to continue working 24-hours per day, if required, until October 2023. Working overnight helps to minimize daytime traffic impacts to the area. Ongoing construction at this intersection will continue into 2024.

What to expect:

- Crews have been permitted to work 24-hours per day, if required, at the 23
 Avenue and 111 Street intersection.
- Beginning on/around August 7, crews will be excavating areas to construct a
 drainage lift station for the LRT underpass, and site shafts will be built at the
 northeast and southwest corners of the intersection.
- Overnight work is permitted at this intersection until October 2023.
- Access to ETS bus stops near this intersection will be maintained.
- Every effort will be made to reduce the impact to the public.
