

Construction Notice - Capital Line South LRT

Tree removals on 111 Street from Saddleback Road to 12 Avenue

Beginning on/around June 1, 2023, crews will begin tree removals along the west side of 111 Street from Saddleback Road to 12 Avenue. This work is necessary to prepare for drainage relocations and LRT bridge construction for the Capital Line South LRT extension. Forestry crews will be removing 12 trees just south of Saddleback Road, as well as trees on the north and south sides of Blackmud Creek ravine. The work in this area will occur during daytime hours and is anticipated to occur from early June until December 2023.

The City of Edmonton makes every effort to preserve and protect trees. The City also abides by applicable migratory bird nesting regulations to protect wildlife in the area. As part of the full landscaping plan for the project, the City will be adding trees and plantings along sections of the alignment once construction is completed. More trees will be planted than removed.

What to expect:

- Beginning on/around June 1, 2023, crews will begin necessary tree removals along the west side of 111 Street from Saddleback Road to 12 Avenue.
- Crews will need to remove 12 trees south of Saddleback Road, as well as trees on the north and south sides of Blackmud Creek ravine. Work will occur during daytime hours.
- This work is necessary to prepare the area for drainage relocations as well as LRT bridge construction over Blackmud Creek ravine.
- On the maps below, the areas outlined in “black” represent the tree removal areas.
- Every effort will be made to reduce the impact to the public.
