Century Park Development Update Michael Walters, Ward 10 Councillor

In 2004, a plan to transform the old Heritage Mall site into a mixed-use Transit Oriented development was put in place. Additionally, in 2013, a bylaw was approved by City Council for the relocation of the Park & Ride to allow for the further buildout of the site.

Originally, the idea looked to have people living near the places they shop, and for those living on the site, as well as in the surrounding communities, to have access to the then proposed LRT station, making access to transit a reality.

If we fast forward to 2015, what we see are a few residential towers and a 1200 stall parking lot, clearly not aligning with the original vision for this site.

However, given that the owner of the land is becoming more interested in fulfilling vision for the site, and that our lease for the Park & Ride is set to expire in 2020, I, along with members of our City Administration are currently working diligently with the land owner to work to find an effective solution for all that balances the City's current needs, as well as the land owner's desire.

Once we are further along in the process, we will be looking to hold a broader community discussion as to your community vision for Century Park. In the meantime, I will continue to keep the community league apprised of all the news related to Century Park.
