EPCOR Flood Mitigation Dry Pond

A reminder the new grass field at Steinhauer School is closed until Fall 2022. As a Community we collaborated with EPCOR for four years on the plans and design of the fields and we are grateful to EPCOR ongoing commitment to our community. They have created excellent new fields that we will enjoy for years to come.

EPCOR will keep the fields fenced off until the fall to let the grass and trees grow strong roots. We invite residents to stay off the fields and respect the fences. While the main playing area is fenced off the City of Edmonton will cut the grass in the two rink areas for our use. The Ermineskin Park, just down 106th Street, is open for your use as well. Please note the two rinks are not an off leash park.

Community Safety Data Portal

The Edmonton Police Service invites you to explore the [Community Safety Data Portal](#)! This interactive platform provides access to data including crime statistics and trends occurring in Edmonton. The goal of this interactive platform is to improve community awareness of policing activity and engage citizens in crime prevention strategies so that we can work in partnership to build safer communities.

Data is refreshed every day, with a 24-48 hour delay before it is published on the map. The occurrences had to have taken place within Edmonton and reported to EPS. To anonymize the location of the incident the point on the map is relocated to the closest intersection to where they occurred and should be considered approximate. Do not rely on any information viewed within the CSDP to make decisions or comparisons regarding the safety or crime levels for any particular area.


Scouts

The 59th Edmonton Scouts (Orange troop) meet regularly from September through June in the Ermineskin Community League hall. As one of the largest Scout groups in Alberta, the 59th requires a range of facilities to accommodate our Beaver colony (ages 5-7 years), two Cub packs (8-10), two Scout troops (11-14) and Venturer company (14-17). We are most grateful to Ermineskin for enabling us to use your hall to run our weekly programs. Our Scout troop currently has eighteen youth members (boys and girls), several of whom live in the Ermineskin community. We are a very active troop, pursuing a wide variety of activities and challenges over the course of the year. During the 2021-22 Scouting year, our activities have included the following: canoeing, hiking, cooking competitions, first aid training, downhill and cross-country skiing, learning winter survival skills, snowshoeing, leather crafting, archery and pellet rifle shooting and

an “Amazing Race” Scout skills competition. We have run several day camps (fall and winter) and are very much looking forward to resuming overnight camping in June (our first weekend camp since the pandemic began). This camp will engage the Scouts in activities including horseback riding, zip lining and training in the safe use of knives, axes, saws, camp stoves and lanterns, as well as Scouting traditions like campfire skits and songs. We were also pleased to provide a small service to the Community League recently by doing a spring clean-up of the area around the hall and in Steinhauer Park. 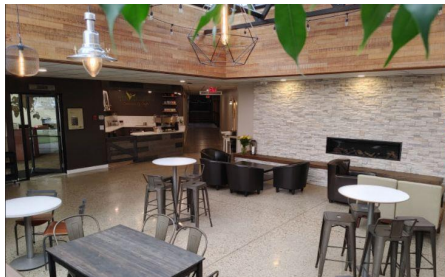
