



Over the past month I have received an increasing amount of emails filled with concerns regarding drug usage and crime in the neighborhood and what could be done about it.

Listening to your concerns, I had taken actions to ensure the Ermineskin community's concerns can be properly addressed. I discussed community safety issues with an Edmonton Police Service officer responsible for the Ermineskin. My office facilitated communication between the Edmonton Police Commission and Ermineskin constituents.
